THE TOM COLLEY MEMORIAL FUND

PURPOSE: To provide partial funding to be used as seed money for travel support for selected Bluefield State College students who seek to participate in BSC’s study abroad programs at its international partner institutions only.

ELIGIBILITY: Applicants must be graduates of the following West Virginia and Virginia high schools. West Virginia high schools: Bluefield High School; Princeton Senior High School; Montcalm High School; Pikeview High School; Riverview High School; Mt. View High School; Wyoming East High School; Westside High School. Virginia high schools: Bland High School; Graham High School; Tazewell High School; Richlands High School; Twin Valley High School.

CRITERIA: The following criteria will be used as the basis for the scholarship awards:

1. Applicant’s prior academic performance.
2. Applicant’s prior leadership performance.
3. Applicant’s community service
4. Applicant’s need and potential for success.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The Fund Advisory Committee will recommend recipients of the Scholarship to the Community Foundation of the Virginias Scholarship Committee with final approval from the Board of Directors of the Foundation. If there are no qualified applicants, no awards will be made that year.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: To apply for a scholarship from The Tom Colley Memorial Fund, applicants must:

Complete an application packet by March 15 each year. This packet will include:

1. An application form.
2. Description of how studying abroad will help the applicant in his/her chosen major and future life.
3. Any other information deemed necessary by the Fund Advisory Committee.

AWARDS: The scholarship(s) will normally be \$200.

LIMITATIONS: Scholarship funds may be used only for travel related expenses. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the Center for International Understanding, Inc. in the applicant's name. Scholarships are awarded without regard to race, sex, religion, age, or national origin.
