

Articulation Agreement

Between

Monroe County Technical Center and

Bluefield State College School of Education, Humanities, and Social Sciences

Monroe County Technical Center in Monroe County, WV and Bluefield State College (BSC), agree to allow students who have completed the Careers in Education program to transfer credits (10) and waive the requirements for the following BSC courses:

Monroe Course	BSC Course	Credit Hours Earned
Foundations in Education	EDUC 110 Foundations in Education	2 credits
Student Learning, Development and Diversity	EDUC 160 Diversity in Education	2 credits
Human Development	EDUC 200 Child and Adolescent Growth and Development	3 credits
Elementary Literature Secondary Literature	READ 270 The Reading Process	3 credits

The following general principles guide this agreement:

- This agreement is solely intended for students who have completed courses and volunteer hours in the Careers in Education Program.
- Students must maintain a 2.5 cumulative grade point average or 18 composite ACT in order to enroll in BSC.
- A student who has completed the certificate program and successfully met high school graduation requirements, may enroll into the BS degree program in Elementary Education at BSC provided they have met all criteria and been accepted into the college.
- Students who have completed the Careers in Education Program will request the program completion transcript be sent to BSC.
- Students who have completed the Careers in Education Program will be given equal consideration for financial assistance and will be eligible to complete for academic scholarships at BSC.
