- 1. You are a successful GED® only completer with a score of at least 250 prior to January 1, 2002 or 2500 after January 1, 2002; TASC® only completer with 550 minimum-average of all 5 parts; OR GED and TASC combined GED 500 minimum average of those tests and TASC 550 minimum average of those.
- 2. You are a resident of West Virginia and show financial need based upon FAFSA application
- 3. You have been accepted or are enrolled full-time (12 or more hours) in school
