- 4. Coordinate and centralize campus efforts for all veterans, together with the creation of a designated space (even if limited in size).
- 5. Collaborate with local communities and organizations, including government agencies, to align and coordinate various services for veterans.
- 6. Utilize a uniform set of data tools to collect and track information on veterans, including demographics, retention and degree completion.
- 7. Provide comprehensive professional development for faculty and staff on issues and challenges unique to veterans.
- 8. Develop systems that ensure sustainability of effective practices for veterans.
