#### THE TOM COLLEY MEMORIAL FUND

View High School; Wyoming East High School; Westside High School. Virginia high schools: Bland High School; Graham High School; Tazewell High School; Richlands High School; Twin Valley High School.

CRITERIA: The following criteria will be used as the basis for the scholarship awards:

- 1. Applicant's prior academic performance.
- 2. Applicant's prior leadership performance.
- 3. Applicant's community service
- 4. Applicant's need and potential for success.

SELECTION PROCEDURE: The Fund Advisory Committee will recommend recipients of the Scholarship to the Community Foundation of the Virginias Scholarship Committee with final approval from the Board of Directors of the Foundation.
