## **Connect Global US-MENA Final Report**

## Main activities and group dynamics:

On this final week of the program, facilitators encouraged students to continue leading thought-provoking discussions about the current global challenges that affect their countries. As they thoroughly discussed the global and social issues, participants reflected on how they can play an active role in addressing the issues they discussed throughout the program.

Facilitators shared several instances where students were listening to each other actively and asking questions to learn more about each other's cultural backgrounds. Students demonstrated a high level of interest in each other's perspectives and were very curious about how the discussed issues are affecting their respective countries. After they closed the discussions, participants took time to reflect on the group process and shared thoughts about final takeaways of the semester.

By the end of the session, students participated in the recognition activity and typed the names of peers that impacted them. This activity was an opportunity for students to show appreciation and gratitude towards each other.

This week, most facilitators rated the sessions as "Good" or "Excellent". Some described the final sessions as insightful and dynamic. Facilitators reported how quiet and shy students built confidence throughout the sessions and became more engaged in the dialogue process. Some of them also commented on the language- related progress the have made in the past eight weeks.

## Attendance and technical updates:

The absence rate for the final week of the program was relatively low and most students were able to attend their sessions. Thank you so much for your constant support and for reminding your students of the importance of attendance throughout the semester. On the technical front, no major issues were reported.
