

Apply Now for West Virginia Legislative Internships

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE September 19, 2017

The West Virginia state legislature annually provides three internships for West Virginia college and university students. All internships are open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have passed at least one political science course. The Frasure-Singleton Internship Program is a one-week program. Meals and hotel lodging are provided. The Judith A. Herndon Fellowship Program is a full-semester program where students will be paired with a member of the state legislature throughout the duration of the program. Each Herndon Fellow will receive a stipend of \$1,300 per month (\$5,200 total). For graduate students, there is the Walter Rollins Scholars Proram and the Robert W. Burk, Jr. Student Intern Program, each which lasts from January 5 to April 6, 2018 during the legislative session. Each Rollins-Burk recipient will receive a stipend of \$1,400 per month (\$5,600 total).
