• Enrollment:

- o Increase in 15 students over Census reported on 10/15
- Dual Enrollment Liaison position
 - To ensure they continue education at BSU
- Readmits
 - Down had 300 to 400 before loss of program
 - Need staff to concentrate on recruiting readmits
 - Loss TRIO government grant 2 years ago
 - Need to reapply
- o FTE's up 3.32% Headcount up 4.65%
