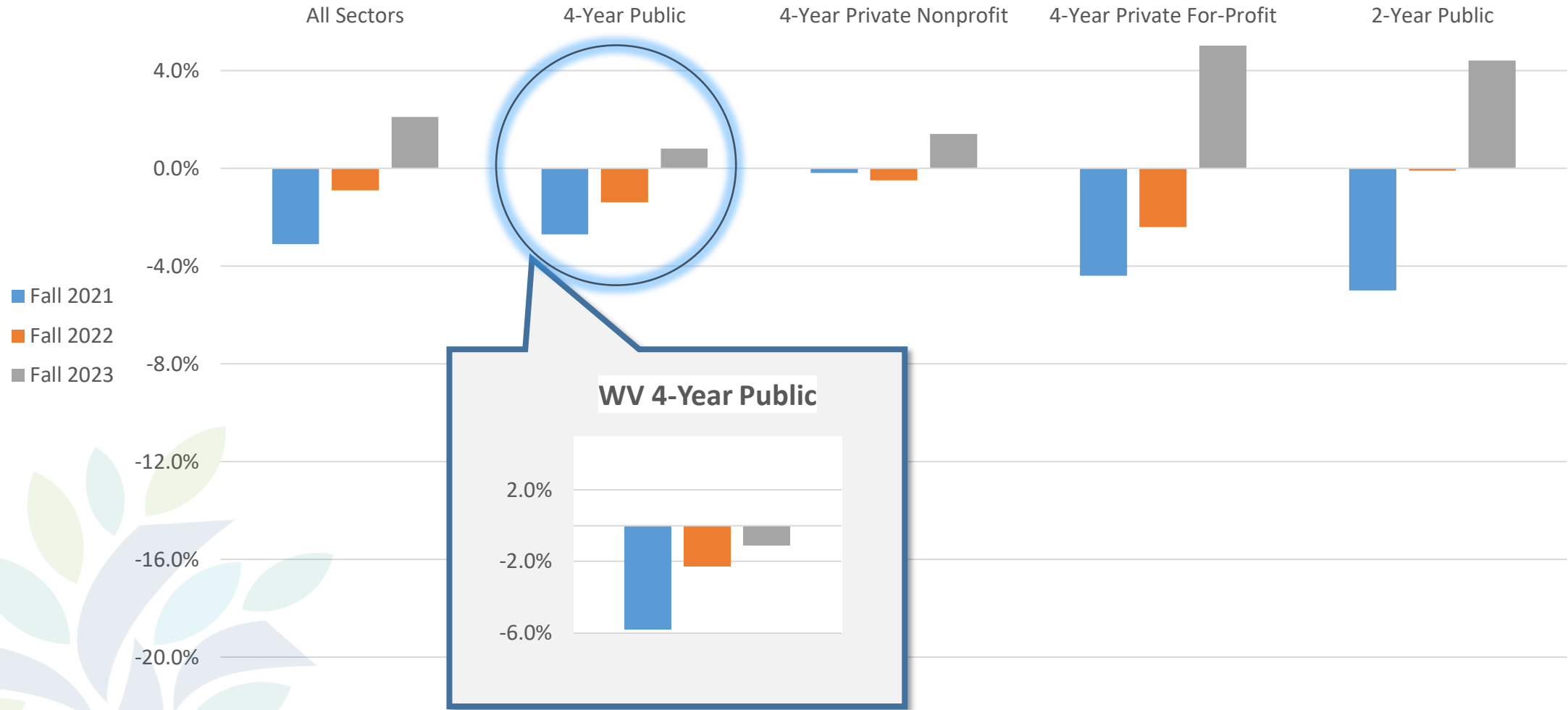

## Undergraduate Enrollment

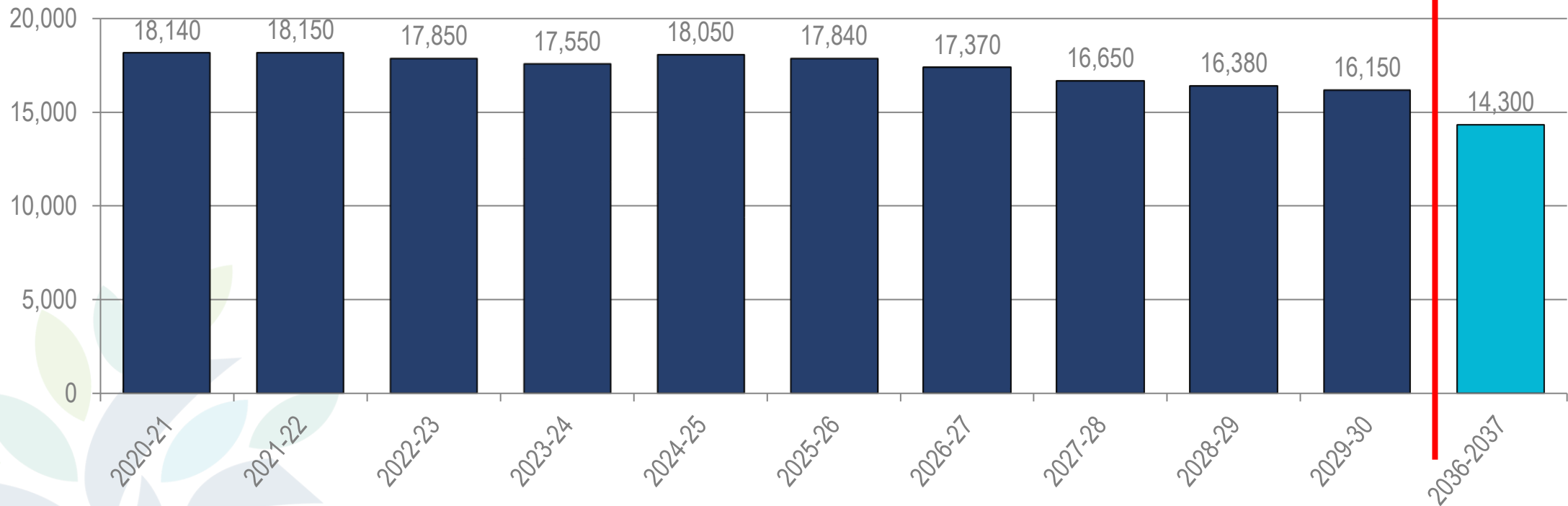

## 2020-21 to 2036-37 Academic Years

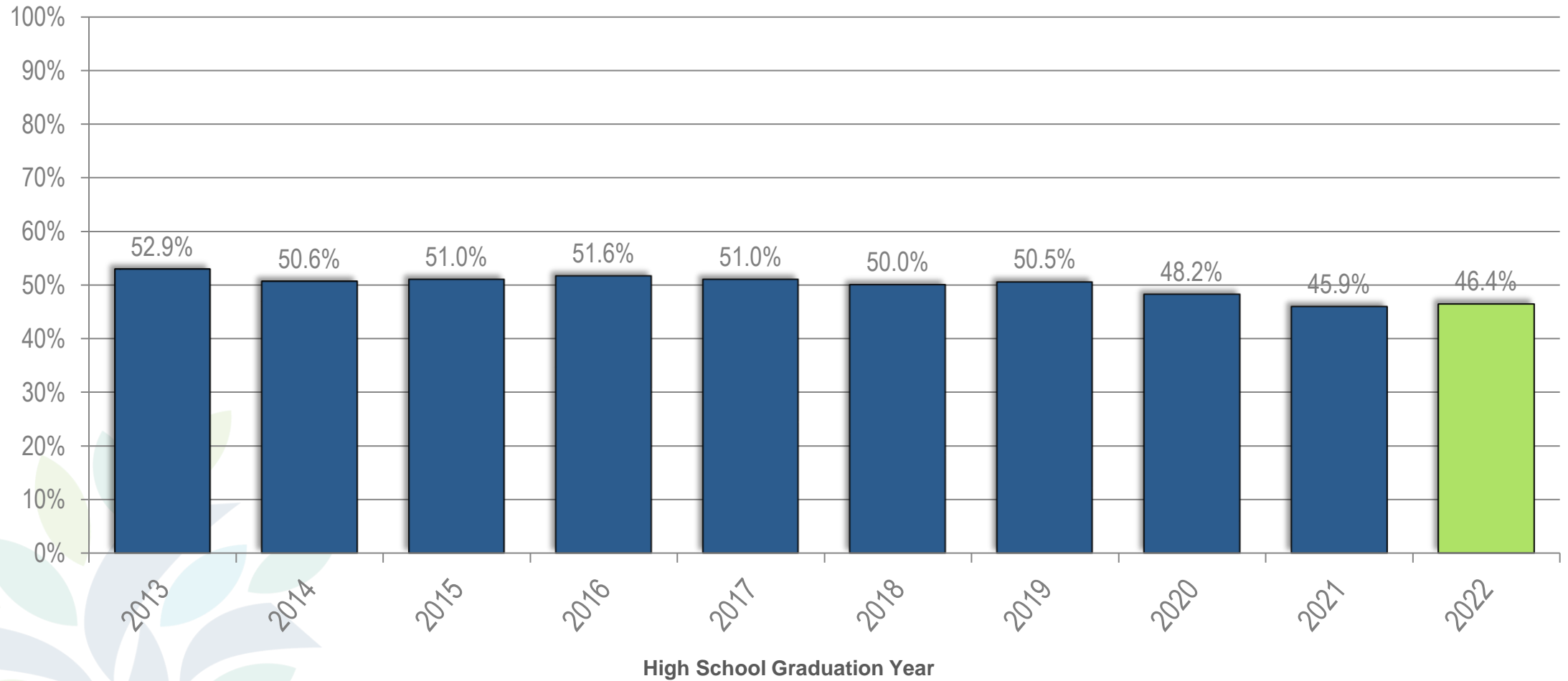
According to WICHE, the number of graduates produced by public and private high schools in West Virginia will continue to decline.

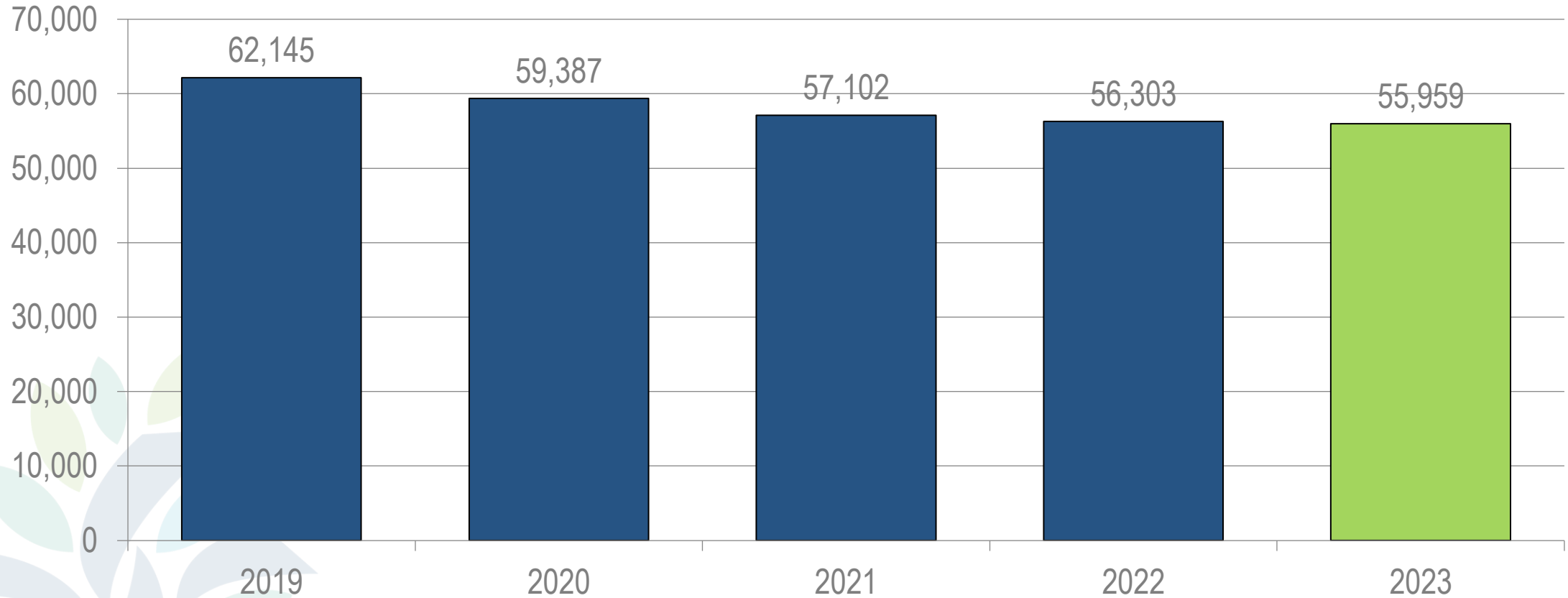

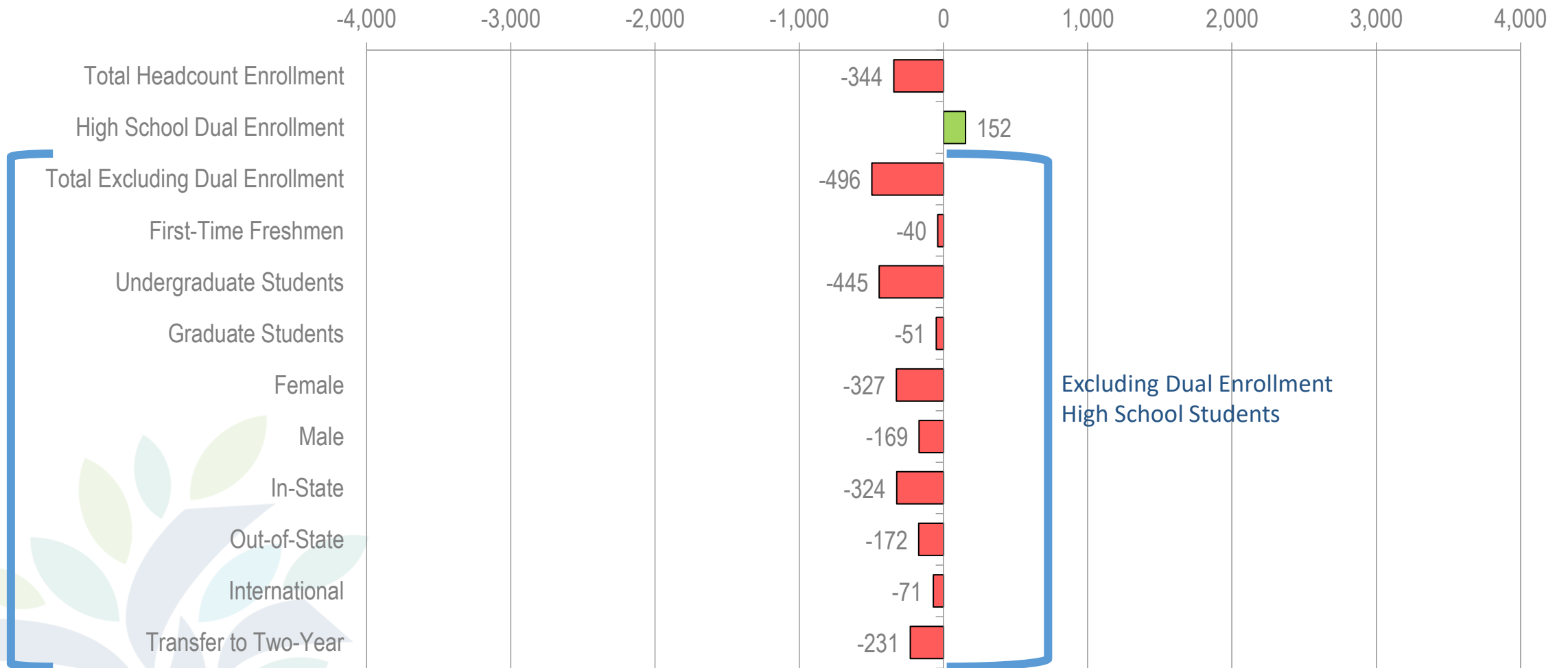

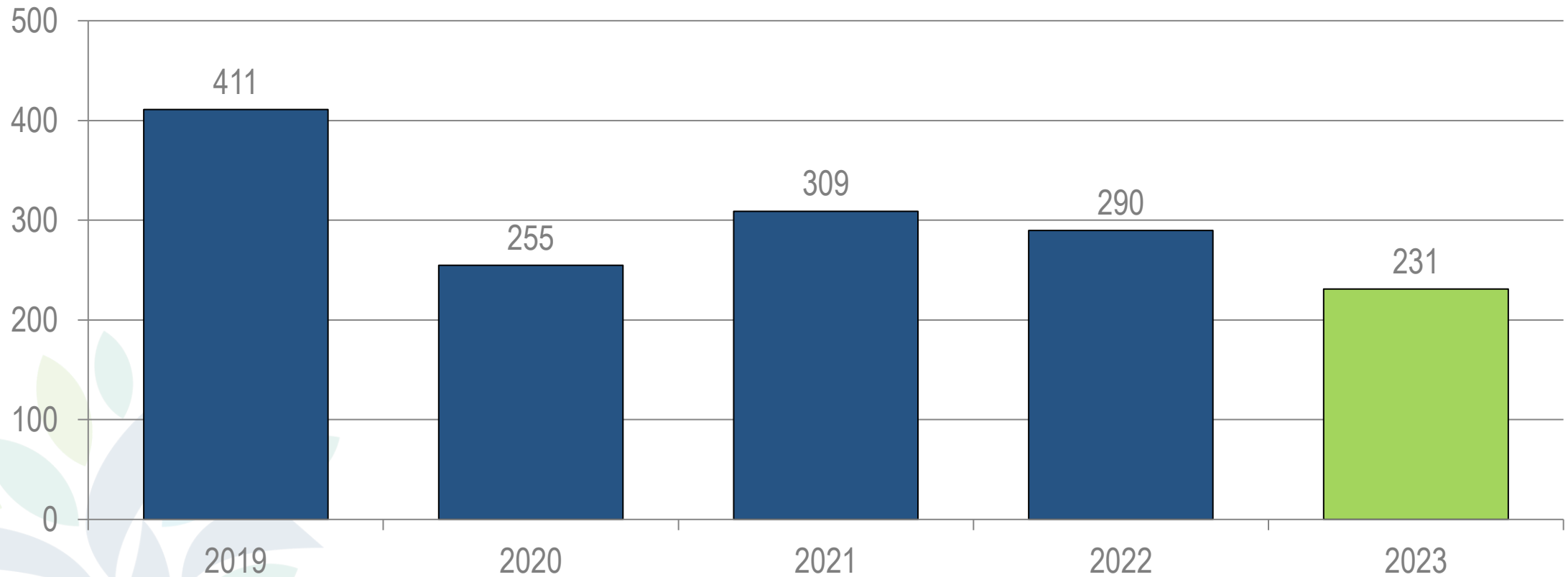

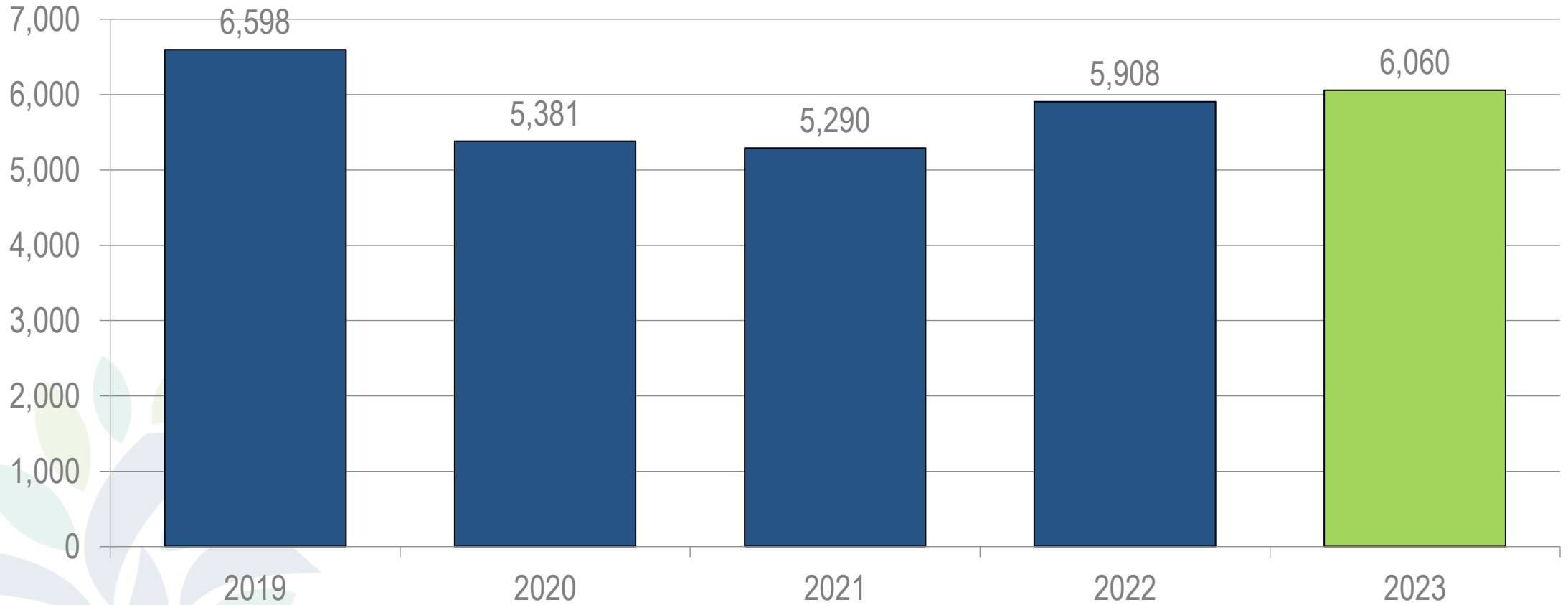

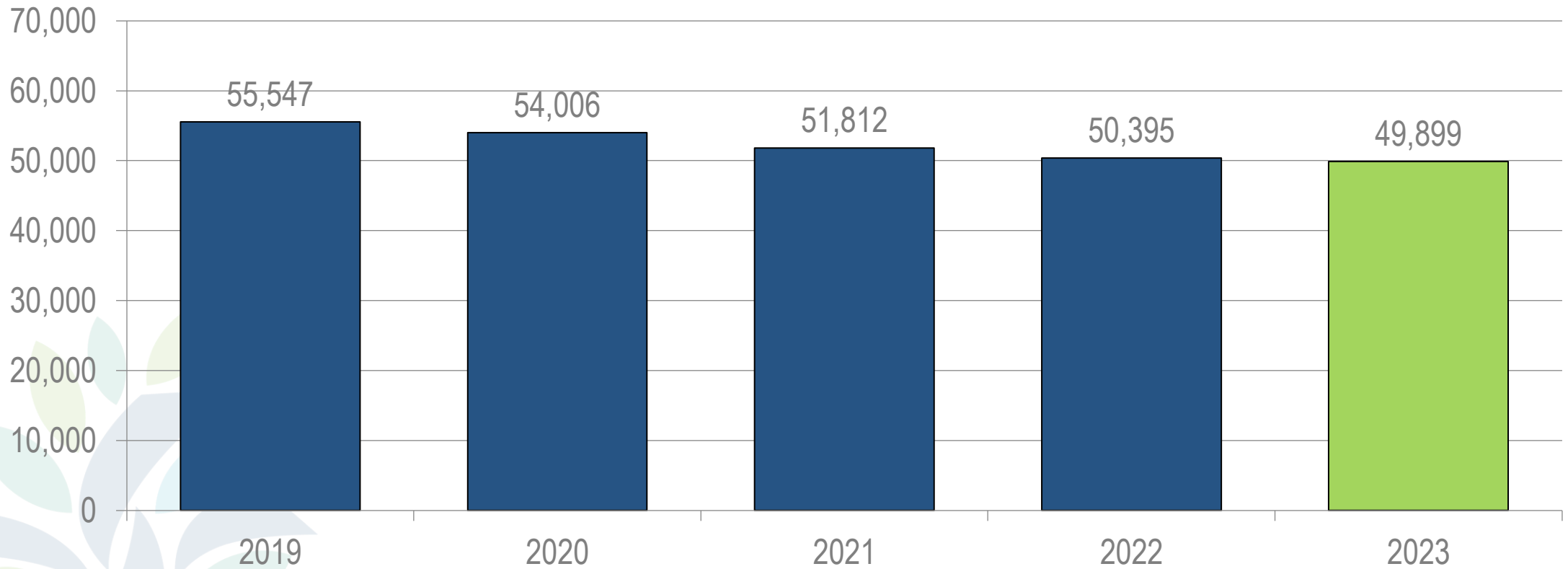

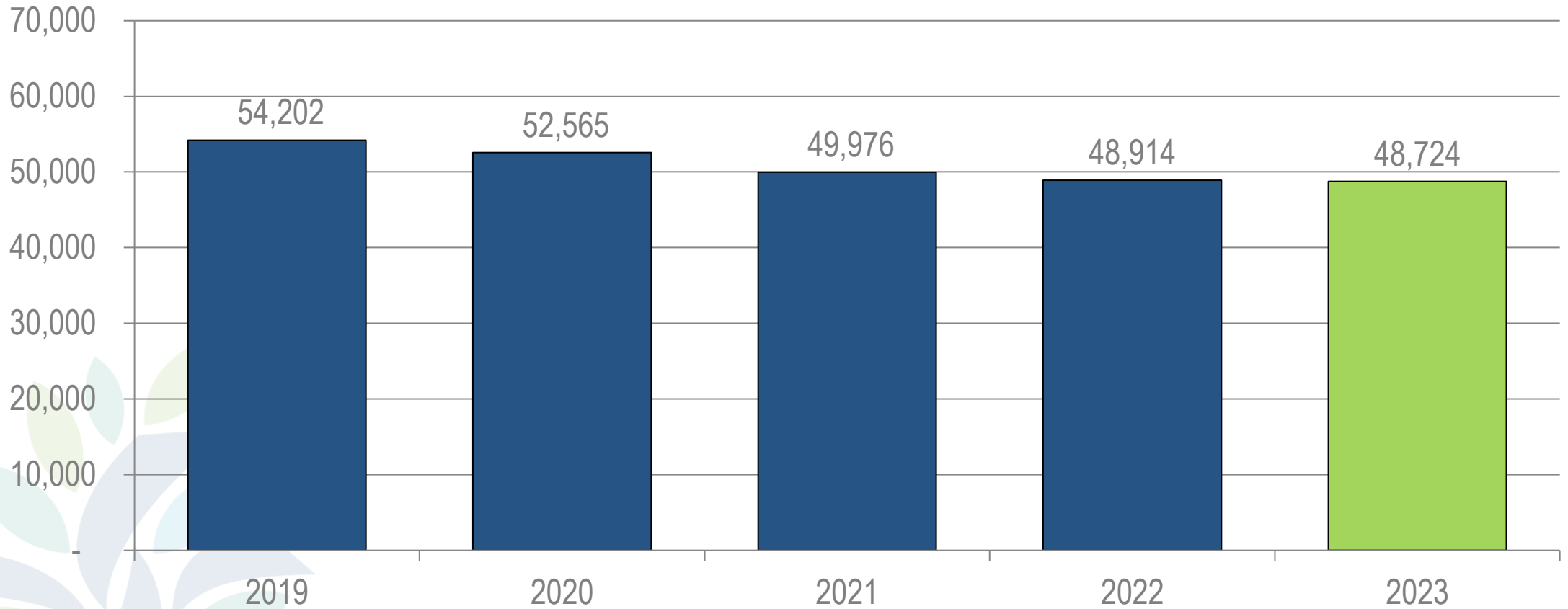

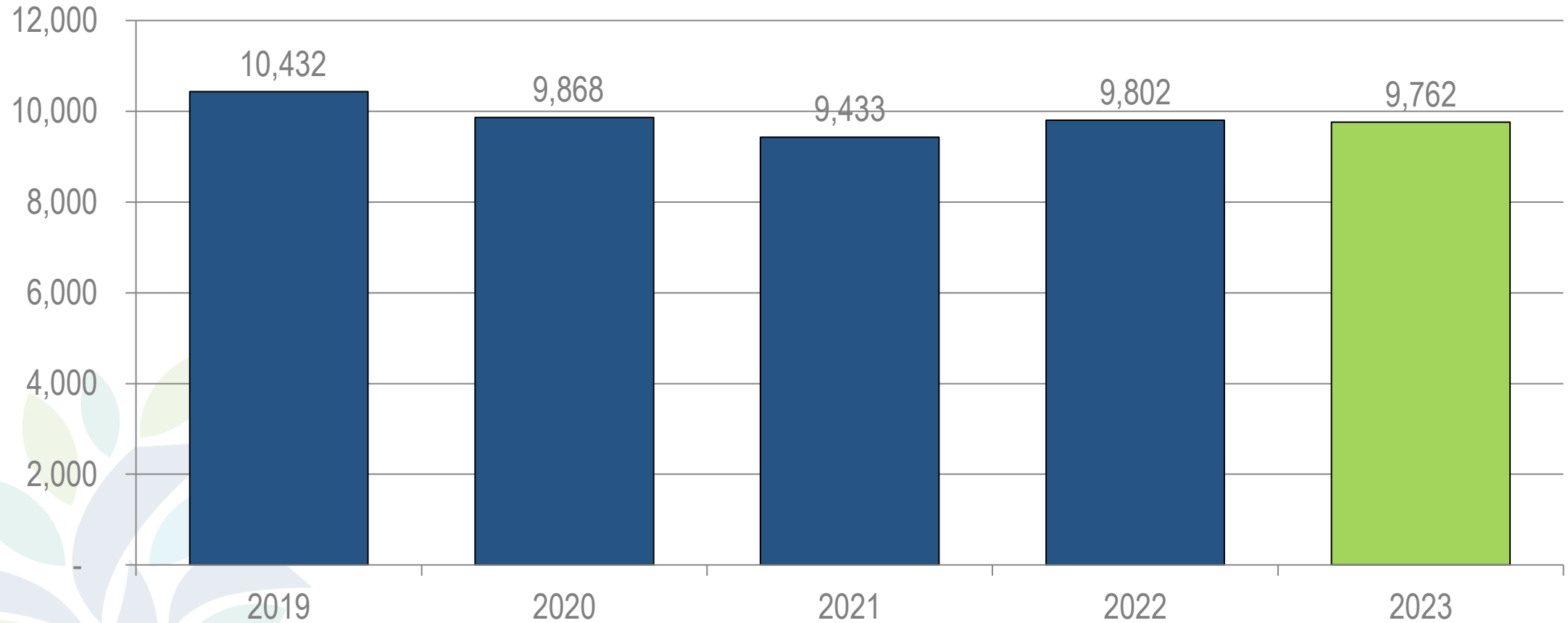

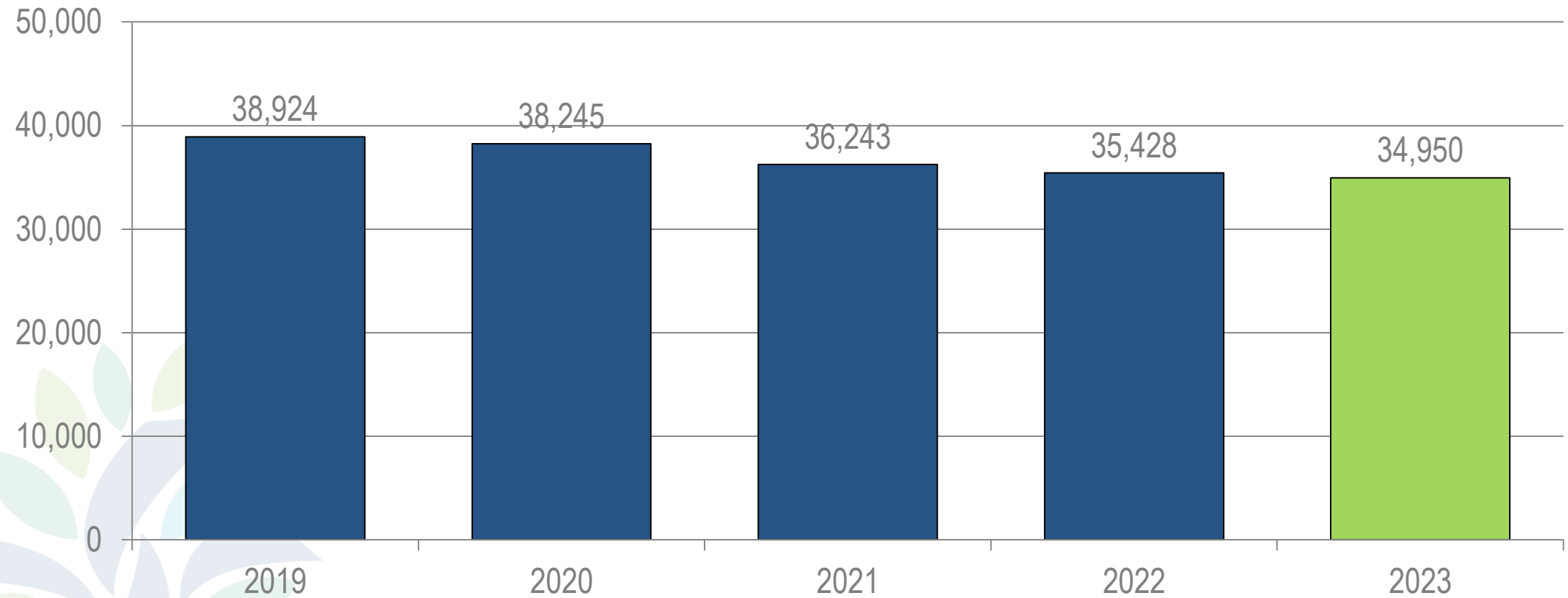

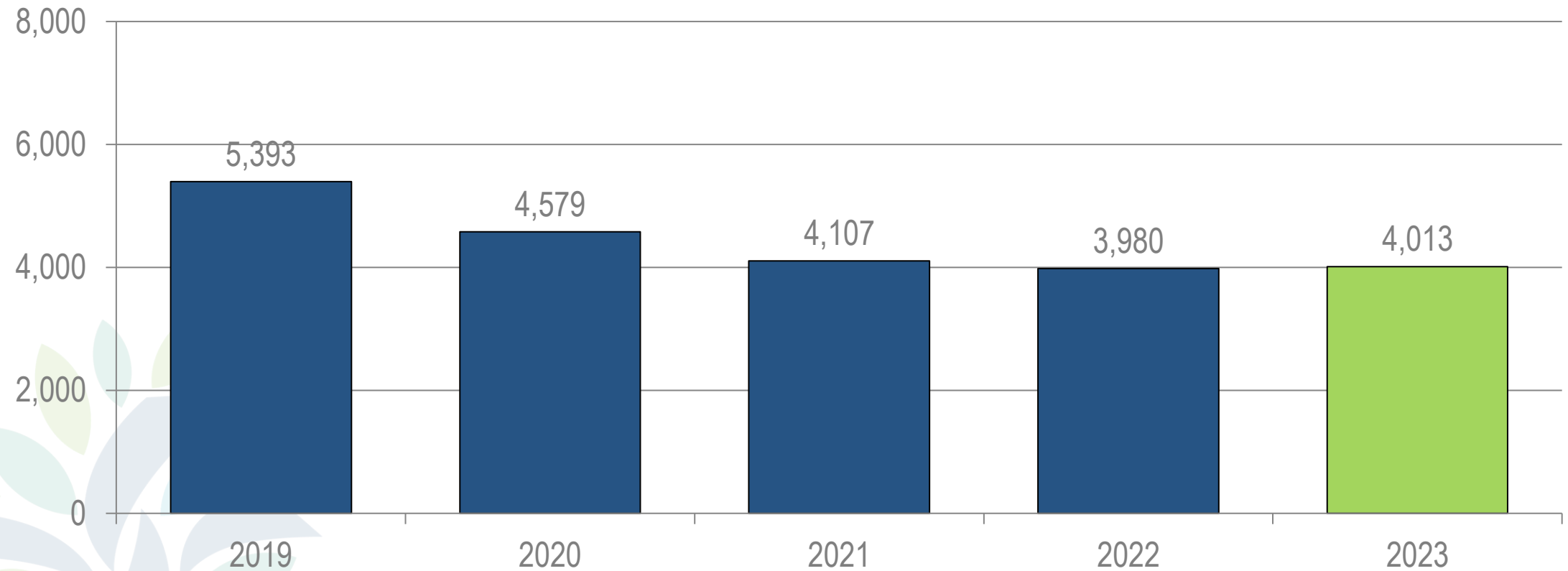

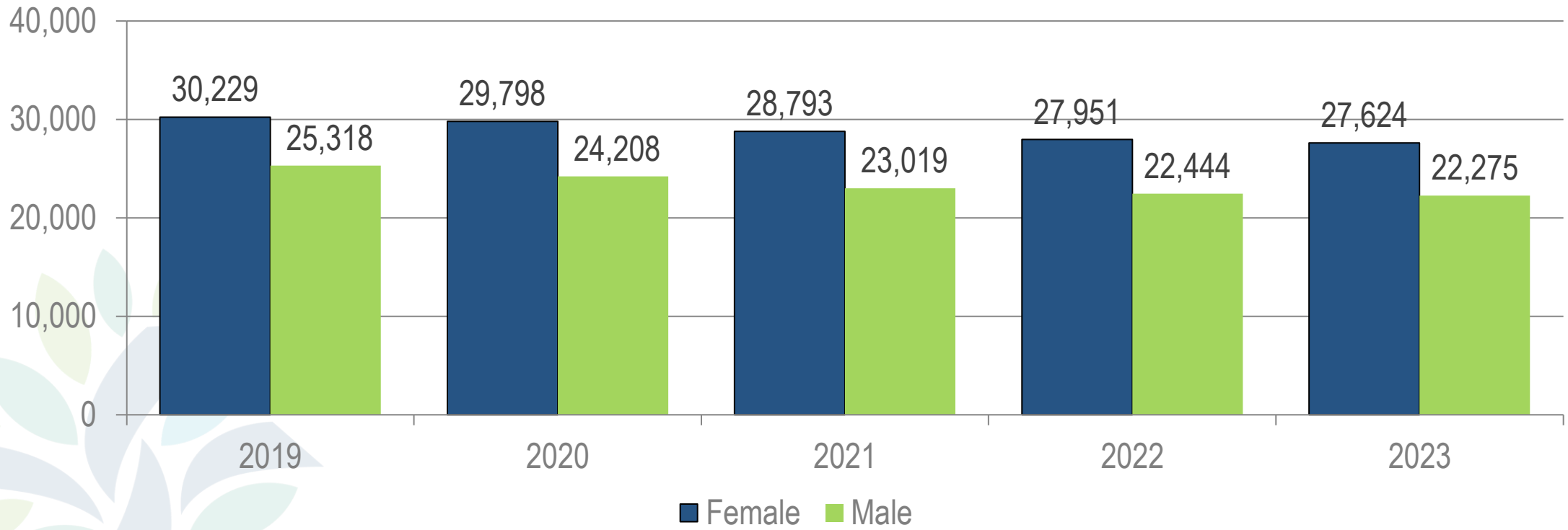

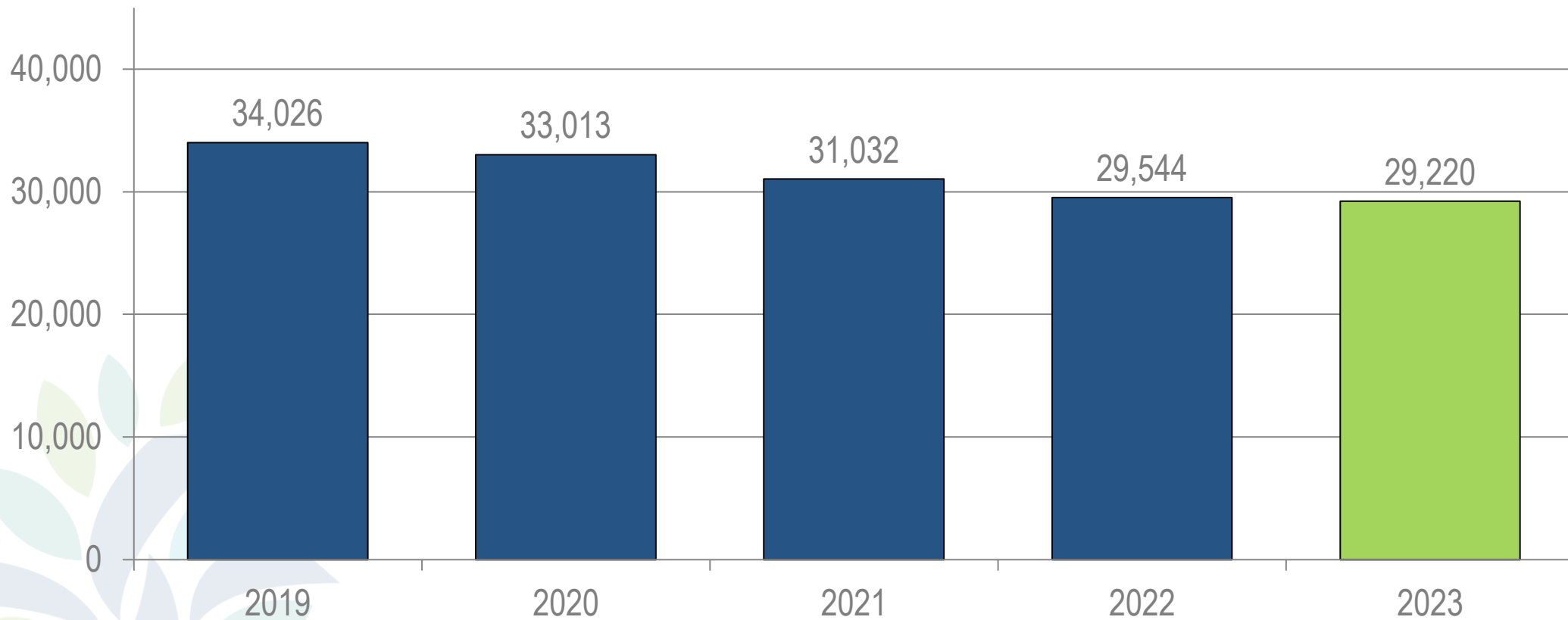

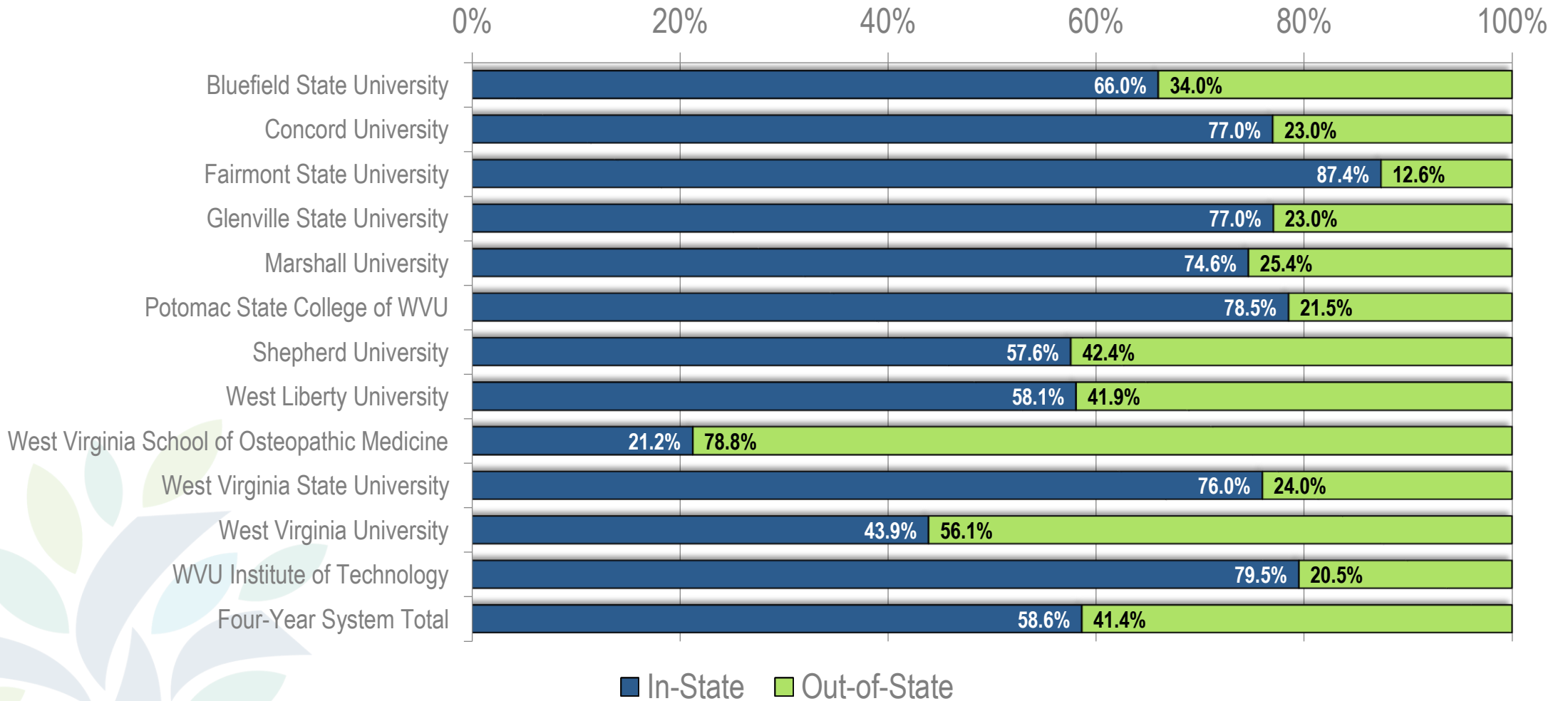
