## **Professional Licensure and Certification Disclosure**

Each state may have different professional licensure and certification requirements. Students who are considering an academic program that may allow them to pursue professional licensure in their state are strongly encouraged to check their state's information and contact the appropriate licensing agency to seek information and additional guidance before beginning a program outside of their state. Our academic programs leading to licensure or certification have been designed to meet and exceed the accreditation and licensure/certification requirements as well as prepare students to apply for licensure/certification exams.

If your goal is to practice your chosen profession in a state other than West Virginia (WV), this professional licensure disclosure notifies you to check on the licensing requirements for the state where you will seek employment. NC-SARA maintains a **Professional Licensure Directory**, which provides contact information for some programs that lead to a professional license, professional licensure FAQs, and a listing of licensure and accrediting agencies.

Students who plan to pursue licensure outside of West Virginia should be aware that state licensure requirements are subject to changes. While a program may originally meet the educational requirements for licensure, changes in requirements could impact the program's ability to meet any new educational requirements. It is the responsibility of students to check with their state licensure board to confirm licensure requirements and make sure they meet those requirements.
